An animal cannot change its hunting grounds.

15 Possible answer:

You mustn't talk to the monkeys  
 You mustn't drink where the monkeys drink  
 You mustn't go where monkeys go  
 You mustn't hunt where monkeys hunt  
 You mustn't turn round when monkeys throw things at your head.

17 Possible answers:

*To communicate with the other animals so that they will not attack him; so that they understand he is their brother, etc.*

*Mowgli only kills when he is hungry. Men kill when they are hungry and for nothing or for sport.*

*Kaa likes eating monkeys and Mowgli looks like a monkey. But Mowgli says he is his brother, which is the right thing to say so that Kaa does not kill him.*

18–20 Open answers.

21 Possible answers:

*Chil tells Baloo and Bagheera where Mowgli is.*

*Kaa kills a lot of monkeys and breaks a wall*

*The snakes do not kill him*

*His two friends ask Kaa for help and fight the monkeys.*

22 Possible answer:

*Yes, Kaa asks Mowgli to leave and take his friends away because he knows the effects of the snake dance.*

24 Possible answer: The boy from the jungle cannot speak the language of men, he has cuts on his skin, can't sleep in a bed, he knows how to hunt, he can communicate with animals, etc.

25 Possible answer: Mowgli tries to learn the language of men so he listens carefully and repeats what he hears. He also tries to learn the ways of men, etc.

26 Possible answer: Mowgli laughs at the stories told by the village men because he knows what has really happened and not what men think has happened.

27 Possible answer: Rama's feet hit Shere Khan.

31 Possible answers:

*The wolves are afraid Mowgli will not be the same as before Mowgli explains why he has left the jungle.*

*Mowgli is angry with the village hunter because he wants to take the tiger's coat away*

*Messua tells Mowgli to escape because the villagers want to hurt him.*

*Akela tells Mowgli that the men did not understand Mowgli either.*
